




If you have problem finding your course or have any questions concerning the planner, contact the Coordinators immediately!

3. Timetable conflict

It may happen that two teachers plan their classes at the same time. They are not aware of your whole schedule, and may choose the same date and hour. That is why you should always keep an eye on situations like that.

If something like this happens, you need to contact the teacher (or the Coordinator) immediately in order to plan other date.

Skipping your class because you *"did not know what to do"* is not an excuse. As an adult, you need to be aware of that.


